"It was a challenge, but also a great opportunity for the company,' says Production Manager Antonio Fassina. "In the initial phase the path was uphill, we experienced a choice outside the comfort zone by bringing people with very different backgrounds into the company. From this challenge we learnt a lot and had great satisfaction. It was an opportunity to grow humanly and professionally. In the future we will definitely continue to pursue this project, in the knowledge that we have the tools to foster inclusion. It is always the people who make the difference. A network of



help has also been set up among colleagues to teach Italian to newcomers, who have integrated".
